You will generally have a list of tasks that you are expected to complete during the time that you are here, like feeding, letting dogs out, changing water, etc., and you will often have to work independently or with others. We expect you to be committed to the times you are scheduled and to take the position seriously while enjoying your time with the dogs. Please keep this in mind when applying and considering if this position is a good fit for you! Our goal is for our volunteers to feel comfortable while getting things done efficiently and correctly.
